

# Education Programs at The Exchange

## Tour of the Exchange:

- Recommended Age Range – 5 to Senior Citizen.
- SC Social Studies Education Standards -
  - K – 3.1, 3.2, 3.3, 4.1, 4.2, 4.3, 4.4.
  - 1<sup>st</sup> – 2.1, 2.3, 3.1, 3.3.
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> – 2.1, 2.2, 2.4, 3.5, 4.3.

- Program Description – Step back in time and see The Old Exchange and Provost Dungeon! Program participants will follow a period-dressed docent through all three floors of the building as they learn about The Old Exchange’s connection to the Revolutionary War, the Colonial era, Pirate history, African American history, and the establishment of American Government.
- Duration – 1 Hour.

## Colonial Lifestyles:

- Age Range – 5 to 9.
- SC Social Studies Education Standards –

- Program Description – Learn about life back in Colonial times at The Old Exchange. Participants will follow a Colonial-dressed docent through The Old Exchange and will even take a guided tour of the dungeon. There is also a hands-on activity where participants see Colonial utensils and toys that were commonly used during Colonial times.
- Duration – 1 Hour.

## **Pirate Scavenger Hunt:**

- Age Range – 5 to 13.

- Program Description – Drop anchor in Charleston and learn about the city’s rich pirate history at The Old Exchange and Provost Dungeon. Program participants will follow a pirate-dressed docent as they learn about the Colonial era and piracy in “Charles Town.” Then take a picture scavenger hunt of the city, where participants find and take photos of multiple locations in the city related to pirates.
- Duration – 1 Hour and 30 Minutes.

## **George Washington Scavenger Hunt:**

- Age Range – 6 to 13.
- SC Social Studies Education Standards –

- Program Description – Come and learn about the American Revolution at The Old Exchange, where President Washington was entertained. Program participants will follow a period-dressed docent throughout The Old Exchange as they learn about the history of the Revolutionary War in Charleston, the establishment of American Government, and George Washington’s famous visit to the city. Then get ready to take a picture scavenger hunt where participants will find locations in the city pertaining to George Washington’s Charleston visit.
- Duration – 1 Hour and 30 Minutes.

## **Foundations and Freedom: An African American History Program**

- Age Range - 8 to Adult.
- SC Social Studies Education Standards –
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> – 4.1, 4.2, 4.1, 4.2, 4.3, 4.4, 4.5, 4.6, 5.1.
  - 5<sup>th</sup> – 1.1, 1.2, 1.3, 1.4.

- Program Description – Learn about the history of The Old Exchange and its relation to African American history in Charleston. Program participants will follow a professionally dressed docent as they discuss what events like the American Revolution and the early American Government would have meant for the enslaved population. Groups will also learn about the history of the transatlantic and domestic slave trade in America, and important Charleston African America figures such as Denmark Vesey.
- Duration – 1 Hour.

## **The Road to Civil War:**

- Age Range – 8 to Adult
- SC Social Studies Education Standards –
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> – 4.1, 4.2, 4.3, 4.4.
  - 4<sup>th</sup> – 6.1, 6.3, 6.4.
  - 8<sup>th</sup> – 4.2, 4.3, 4.4, 4.5.
- Program Description – Come to The Old Exchange and Provost Dungeon and learn about its role leading up to the Civil War. Program participants follow a professionally dressed docent through the building, as they explain the use of The Old Exchange during the Nullification Crisis, the domestic slave trade, and South Carolina's secession from the Union.
- Duration – 1 Hour.

# **Summer and Seasonal Programs**

## **Making of a Pirate:**

- Age Range – 4 to 9.
- Program Description – Set sail for The Old Exchange, and get ready to learn all about pirates! Guests get a guided tour of the Dungeon with a pirate docent, then after learning all about pirates they get to make their own paper pirates that they get to take home.
- Duration – 1 Hour.

## **Colonial Christmas:**

- Age Range – 4 to 9.
- Program Description – Seasons Greetings from The Old Exchange and Provost Dungeon! Guests learn about the Colonial era and the American Revolution with a period dressed docent, take a tour of the Dungeon, and learn about holiday traditions from the early days of Charlestown. Guests also get to make their own Colonial Christmas decorations to bring home.
- Duration – 1 Hour.

# Outreach Programs

## **Interview with a Pirate:**

- Age Range – 5 to Senior Citizen.
- SC Social Studies Education Standards –
  - K – 3.1, 4.1, 4.2, 4.3, 4.4.
  - 1<sup>st</sup> – 2.1, 2.4.
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> – 2.1, 2.2, 3.1, 3.3, 4.4.

- Program Description – Have a pirate drop anchor at your location! This is a chance to sit down and talk with a pirate costumed docent while learning about Charleston’s colonial and pirate history. Program participants will be given 10 prepared question cards in total, and the docent will provide answers that relate to the history of South Carolina and piracy. After the prepared questions are asked, guests can ask any additional questions. Also includes pirate-themed items that the docent will display and explain to the group.

## **Interview with a Patriot:**

- Age Range – 6 to Senior Citizen.
- SC Social Studies Education Standards –

- Program Description – Have a patriot bring freedom to your location! The program includes a costumed docent coming to your site and discussing colonial and Revolutionary War history. Participants will be given 10 prepared question cards in total, and the docent will provide answers that relate to South Carolina’s growth from a colony to an independent nation. After the prepared questions are asked, guests can ask any additional questions. Also includes colonial items that the docent will display and explain to the group.
